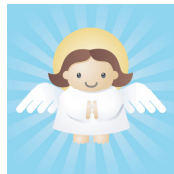

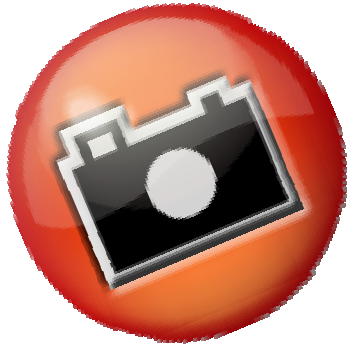

# Spring Scholastic Book Fair

## March 22 ~ 26, 2010

The spring Scholastic Book Fair is coming up quickly, starting March 22<sup>nd</sup> (the week after Spring Break) with set-up and preview and running through the 26th.

I will need **lots** of help for that week, so here is a **great** chance to get some volunteer hours and help the library. Students will fill out a sheet on Monday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> indicating which books they would like to buy. This is your chance as a parent to see what your children are interested in purchasing and to indicate which items they are allowed to buy. **When totaling, please calculate 8.25% tax to be added to the total price.**

We will also continue to take donations for *One for Books*. These donations will be used to help buy books for the classroom libraries. Scholastic also matches these donations to give to a variety of charities, usually with an emphasis in reading and education. As an incentive, there will be a \$25 drawing for those who fill out a donation slip and give a dollar (or more) to the *One for Books* program, which can be used towards purchase at the book fair. Additionally, if \$125 or more is raised through One for Books, an additional recess will be held for the students.

There will be a new book fair event on Wednesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> – a “Grand Event.” The idea of this event is for students to bring a grandparent, or another relative or family friend, to the book fair with them during the day or after school. Students who participate in this event will be entered into a \$25 drawing to be used at the book fair. The winner will be announced on Thursday morning.
